Train Trip to Chicago — 1/18 thru 1/21/2019

The trip details are pretty well put together.

Amtrak Wolverine Train Service # 353 to Chicago

The train leaves Pontiac on 1/18 at 10:00 AM, Detroit at 10:45, Ann Arbor at 11:32, Kalamazoo at 1:31 and arrives at Chicago Union Station at 3:05 PM. See all the stops and station times on the JAGM website.

<u>Amtrak Wolverine Train Service # 352 to Pontiac</u>

The train leaves Chicago Union Station on 1/21 at 1:25 PM, Arrives at Kalamazoo at 4:32, Ann Arbor at 6:34, Detroit at 7:33 and Pontiac at 8:32 PM.

Please book your own train tickets on line at https://www.amtrak.com/home.html. The cost of round trip train travel from Pontiac is about \$100/person (Seniors over 65 get 10% off). There is a cafe on board with sandwiches, snacks and beverages but feel free to bring your own. There is Wifi on-board. I will board in Pontiac and will try to get a bunch of seats saved for the others who will board later. If you can't make it for Friday thru Monday, you can book just the days that you can travel.

Lodging

We will be staying at the Hilton Garden Inn, 10 E. Grand Ave, Chicago, on the corner of Grand and State Streets and next to the Grand Station. It is just

three blocks to the Magnificent Mile known for fine shopping and historic buildings. I was not able to establish a block of rooms.

1 king bed—about \$88 per night; 2 Queen beds—about \$97 per night (plus \$15-18 tax and fees). The hotel has a great location and very good customer ratings. A phone number for central reservations is 855-850-0554.

On the JAGM website there is a list of Chicago Theater Activities that I put together. If there is a consensus we can try to go to some events as a group otherwise you could be on your own. To get around the Chicago area, we will probably buy a several day rail pass for a very reasonable price before we leave Union Station. That will get us to and from the hotel as well as any activities that we wish to partake. You may also want to have an Uber and/or Lyft account ready to go before we get there. I'll create a list of activities out of the AAA Guide book and that will also be available on the JAGM website. Please let me know once you have booked your hotel room and bought your train ticket. Let me know what train station you will be boarding and departing. I will establish a texting group so we can all stay informed even while moving.
