





The concluding order of the day was a visit to the southernmost point in Michigan, the northwestern most point of Ohio, and the


easternmost

Located on the

County, the marker
is a cast iron
block embedded
in the last foot
of pavement and
features a block



M (Go Blue??). A large boulder placed by the Hillsdale Historical Society directs you to the marker - 130 feet south of the bolder and in the middle of the roadway...traffic was light



(nonexistant except for the two horsewomen galloping by) so we took turns standing on the marker and thus "being in three states at one time" enjoyed a "singularly unique experience".


